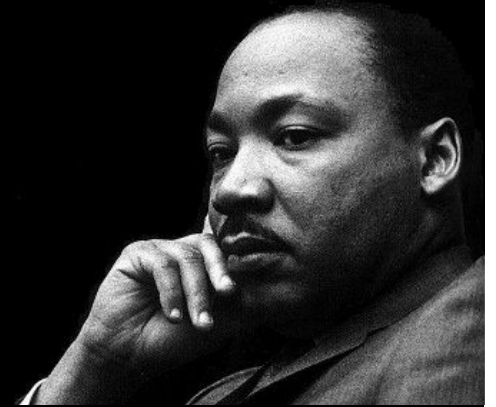
Join hundreds of Fresno residents and keynote speaker Executive Director Roger Palomino commemorate the life of a passionate leader.
