



Safety Works

Sl-o-o-o-o-o-w down. Driving too fast is the number one cause of accidents on foggy days. Never drive with just your parking or fog lights on; use your low beam headlights. The light from high beams will reflect back and cause glare. Be extra cautious as you approach bridges, slow down. Black ice (a thin, invisible, complete coating of ice) forms on top of bridges, causeways, or any stretch of road not paved over solid ground.
