



## **Safety First**

**Safe Shoe Wear** – Here at EOC, we emphasize “safety first”. In order to help prevent slips/trips/falls and to reduce the possibility of injury, it is necessary to ensure that employees wear safe shoes with solid support at all times. The footwear that you wear to work should provide adequate protection from hazards.

Keep in mind that in accordance with our Policy & Procedures, thongs are not acceptable footwear at EOC. In many Programs, open-back and open-toed shoe wear is not acceptable. If you are unsure as to what type of shoe wear is acceptable for your particular Program, check with your supervisor.
