



Safety First

The CHP offers these tips for driving safely in the fog:

- Consider postponing travel until the fog lifts if that's possible.
- Adjust your speed for driving conditions. Speed is the biggest factor in fog-related accidents.
- In extremely foggy conditions, roll down the windows and turn down the car stereo so you can hear vehicles approaching that you can't see.
- Use headlights on **low beam**, not high.
- Use window defrosters and windshield wipers for maximum visibility in foggy conditions.
- Use odometer settings to avoid distance disorientation.
- Allow sufficient time to get to your destination safely. Foggy conditions can double or even triple driving times.
- While law enforcement can help during extreme weather, it is drivers' responsibility to operate vehicles safely. Drivers hold the most power to prevent tragic accidents.
